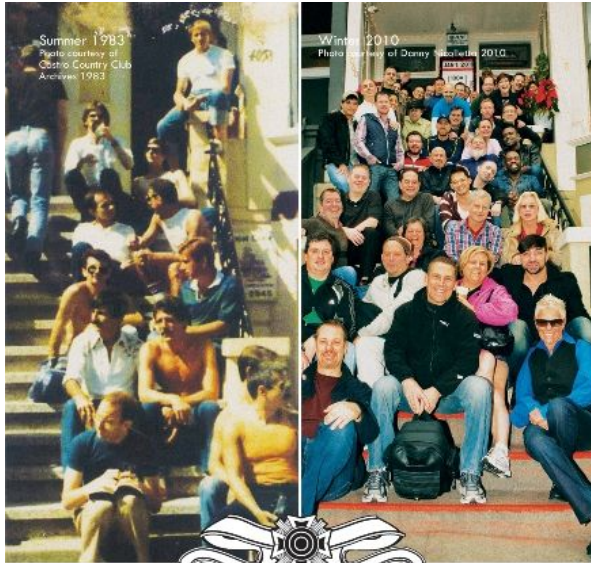
The CCC has been - and continues to be - a spiritual home open to all people in recovery.

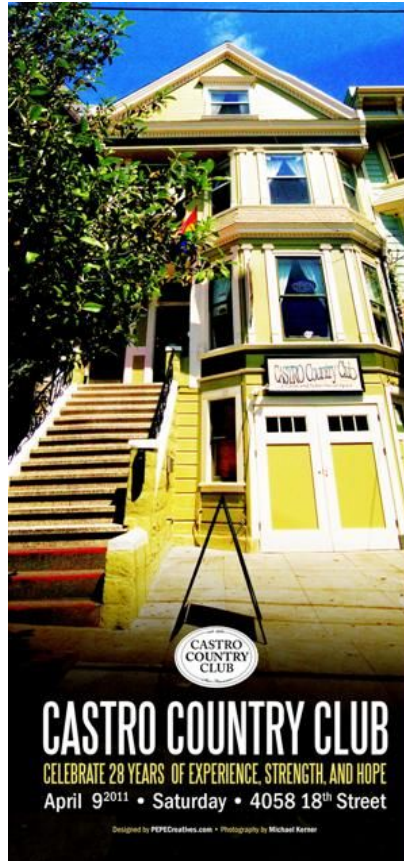
